The company that makes Feliway also makes a pheromone for dogs that are affected by stressful situations. DAP (Dog Appeasing Phermone) is sold in a diffuser, as a spray and also in a convenient collar. DAP is the equivalent of the phermones released during lactation and they act to calm your dog.

D.A.P. collars should be used in new puppies as they move from the shelter or breeder's house to your home. Sprays and plug-ins help calm dogs during stressful situations or can be used lifelong for dogs with fears, aggression or phobias.
